### Applying Online & Submitting Digital Images

Artists may submit 1-3 to be considered for the CCDA Collective Art Collaborative. Please submit artwork in a square 2500 x 2500 px format. If photographing artwork like paintings or drawings, please use the highest quality camera you can. For best lighting, photograph outside on a slightly cloudy day, ensuring there are no shadows present in the photograph.

To submit artwork, please send this application and up to 3 high resolution .png, .jpg, .mp3, .mp4 or .pdf files per artpiece to [anna@ccda.org](mailto:anna@ccda.org) and [christina@ccda.org](mailto:christina@ccda.org) by Sept. 1, 2020 along with social media handles, and digital wallet handle to send any donations from viewers. There are no guarantees of donations, even if your artwork is selected.

Physical artworks will not be accepted.

### Eligibility

Open to all artists 15 years and older creating work exploring Ezekiel 37 1-10. Entries must be original works in any media including: painting, drawing, printmaking, photography, fibers, poems, music, songs, or video. The jurors reserve the right to disqualify any work that varies from the submitted image including: artworks that are a different resolution than stated on the application and artworks that do not show the quality represented by the submitted image.
